The pharmacy manager who has made multiple life-saving ABPM interventions.

The pharmacy manager of Superdrug's Sydenham branch, Saroeun Ing, has provided blood pressure checks to his customers that have resulted in life-saving interventions. Patients with high blood pressure have been offered an ambulatory blood pressure monitoring (ABPM) check to verify their readings and have been issued with blood pressure medication to support their health. One patient in their 60s was reluctant to have their blood pressure taken. But Saroeun put the patient at ease and explained the health benefits the service could have. Given the high reading, the patient was offered an ABPM check, which verified high blood pressure and resulted in the GP seeing them within three hours and giving them a prescription for a new medication.
